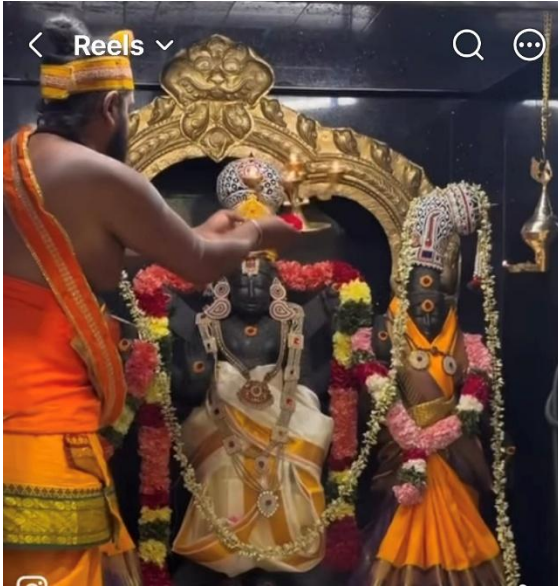

Saturday and Vishnu sahasranamam

Vishnu sahasranamam on Saturdays at 1130 am is witnessed by many devotees.

Communication is an art- What does Hinduism says about our communication.

In Hinduism, communication is viewed as a sacred, powerful tool that shapes karma and consciousness. The Bhagavad Gita and Vedas emphasize that speech should be truthful, uplifting, and peaceful, prioritizing conscious intent and compassion over harsh or divisive rhetoric

Core principles governing communication in Hinduism include:

The Three Tests of Speech: Lord Krishna outlines three conditions for speech: it must be true and honest, kind and non-distressing, and beneficial/uplifting to the listener. If a truth causes unnecessary harm, silence or skillful redirection is preferred.

Four Levels of Speech: Hindu philosophy categorizes communication into four ascending stages of consciousness:

Vaikhari: The physical, spoken words we use every day.

Madhyama: The mental stage where thoughts are formed silently.

Pashyanti: The stage of inner vision where ideas take shape.

Para: The highest, silent form of divine awareness and telepathic understanding.

The Power of Sound (Shabda): Mantras and sacred chants are used not just to exchange information, but to alter the speaker's and listener's state of mind, elevate consciousness, and align with cosmic energies.

Respectful Dialogue (Samvaad): The highest form of communication in Hindu texts is samvaad—a two-way, respectful dialogue between equals. It promotes mutual understanding and the exploration of truth rather than one-way lectures or monologues.

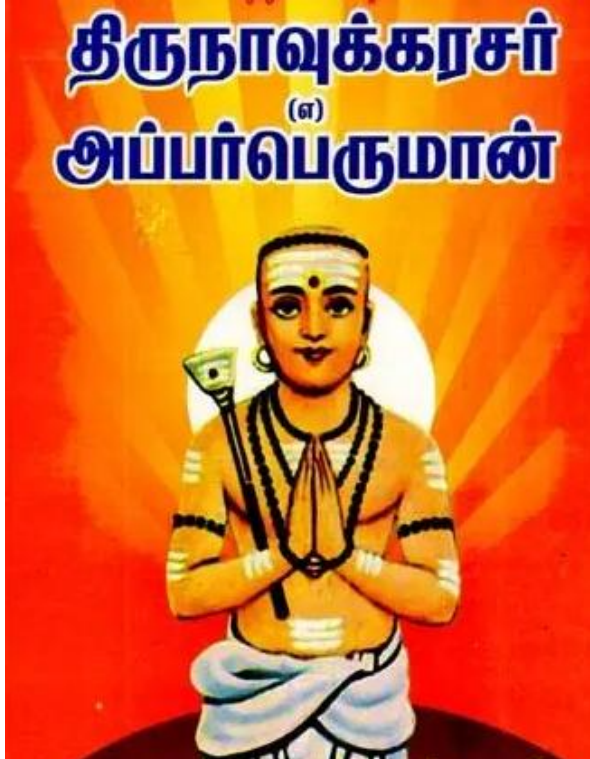
